This puzzle is actually three puzzles.

First you must solve a Sudoku puzzle using the numbers - filling the grid so each row, column and 3x3 box contains the numbers 1-9 once each.

Then use the numbers in shaded cells to solve a Shikaku puzzle - partition the grid into square or rectangular boxes, each containing one number which is the area of that box.

Finally you must use the outlines of boxes from the Shikaku puzzle and the outside labels to place a 45° diagonal mirror in one square of each box, so that the lasers emitted by the lettered rectangles into the grid bounce off the number of mirrors given before reaching their targets. Both sides of the mirrors are reflective.
